Tom Comerford's 4 Provinces of Ireland Tour

Friday 6th November

Depart U.S.A. for Ireland.

Saturday 7th Nov: Athlone, Westmeath

Arrive Shannon Airport, County Clare in the province of Munster, where you will meet Tom and your driver-guide for the week. We travel at our leisure to the town of Athlone, situated in the heart of Ireland, on the banks of the Shannon. Athlone is unique not because it is situated in two counties but in two provinces, Leinster & Connaught. A special area of interest in Athlone is the old quarter, situated on the left bank, in the shadow of the Castle. Tonight we enjoy welcome dinner and drinks. (D,B)

Sunday 8th Nov: Athlone, Westmeath

After breakfast and morning mass we will explore the surrounding areas, which are very special in terms of historical and geographical interest. The waterways are of particular interest, none more so than Lough Ree, one of the many Loughs that form the river Shannon. We will visit the monastic settlement of St. Kieran at Clonmacnoise on the banks of the river and learn of the Viking raids. For tonight, Athlone has a great selection of traditional pubs, just one of which is Sean's, established in the 1900's by Lord Luain (recently confirmed and certified by the Guinness Book of Records as the oldest pub in Ireland.) (B)

Monday 9th Nov: Ballyshannon, Donegal

Travelling this morning through north Leinster, the undulating north midlands basin leads us to Cavan Town, one of the many market towns in the province of Ulster, for a visit to Cavan Crystal. Continuing onwards in a north westerly direction through Ulster's beautiful lake land topography we cross into Northern Ireland, to County Fermanagh for a visit and tour of Belleek Pottery. We travel the short distance to the Atlantic coast and the small town of Ballyshannon for a two night stay at the family owned Dorrian's Imperial Hotel. (B)

Tuesday 10th Nov: Ballyshannon, Donegal

This morning travel through Donegal town and further west along Donegal Bay to the fishing port of Killybegs, one of the largest fishing ports in Ireland, and home to the Atlantic Dawn the largest fishing trawler in the world. The scenery in this most north western county of Ireland is awesome, rugged and imposing, where every turn in the road exposes a different visual delight. We will revel in small villages and rural landscapes, while all the time reflecting on the fact that Donegal, historically, has one of the largest rates of emigration, from Ireland. (B)

Wednesday 11th Nov: Ballina, Mayo

Southbound this morning, we leave Donegal and set our sights on the province of Connought, and Sligo is our point of entry, known as "Yeats Country" after the famous poet and playwright William Butler Yeats. A visit to Lissadell House is a must, home to the Booth family whose links in Ireland from patronage of the arts to the 1916 rising. Afterwards we will pay a visit to the grave of William Butler Yeats, before continuing our journey, this time to the quaint old county town of Sligo, where we will have time to explore or shop at our leisure. Today's travel concludes as we hug the Atlantic coastline once again, for the short drive to our destination Ballina, county Mayo for overnight. (B)

Thursday 12th Nov: Ballina, Mayo

We leave Ballina this morning, with an interesting itinerary ahead of us. First of all we will take in the stunning views around Downpatrick Head, before progressing to one of the cradles of early civilisation the Ceide Fields, where we will learn about the early Neolithic settlers in Ireland and their farming methods. Upon leaving there, we will travel along the old bog road through Bangor and Bellacorick, and return to Ballina. The afternoon is free to explore the old market town, while this evening.. The world is our oyster. (B)

Friday 13th Nov: Ennis, Clare

We head south this morning through the village of Foxford and a visit to the Foxford Woollen Mills, and onwards to the world famous Knock Shrine. Through the farming towns of Claremorris and Tuam to Galway city, Known as the city of the tribes, where you will have free time for shopping in the capital of the West of Ireland. Continue to Ennis, back in the province of Munster where our tour started, for a farewell dinner and final entertainment evening from Tom as we celebrate our through the four provinces, and toast our last evening in Ireland. (D, B)
